Through RPL BOU endeavors to recognise your prior knowledge in two forms:

1. RPL for Access

Those who did not do well in high school results but possess relevant workplace knowledge relating to one of BOU's programmes may apply for admission through Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) process. They will be expected to demonstrate the knowledge. This is called RPL for access.

2. RPL for Credit

If they are found to be competent they will be exempted from doing the course. It is advisable to keep attending the lessons in case one is not found competent.
